We will select six County Award Winners with winning nominations being forwarded to The FA who will choose seven people to receive National Football Workforce Awards for their contribution to football during the 2008-09 season.

In addition Clubs and Leagues can nominate a Young Volunteer (Under 18 at start of the season) for recognition, and an Under 25 volunteer as part of the FA McDonald's V programme.

The Development committee will choose one Young winner and one Under 25 FA McDonald's V volunteer. The FA who in turn will chose National winners to attend The FA Community Shield

County winners will be presented at the AGM meeting in London on Thursday 4th June 2009
