Perfect records fall to leave it tight at the top

Old Parmiterians picked up their first points of the season at home on Saturday, and in doing so ended Old Hamptonians' 100% start to the season.

In a game of few chances James Wood scored the only goal on the half hour, finishing at the near post after good work down the left hand side from Joe Mariani.

In the second half Dave Stephens had a great opportunity to double the home side's advantage, but was unable to capitalise. Sean Clements forced the Hamptonians keeper into an excellent save, having beaten several defenders on an excellent run, as Parmiterians continued to press. With clear-cut openings at a premium, the visitors pressed but were unable to find an equaliser.

Elsewhere in the Premier League, early season pace-setters Bealonians were beaten 3-2 away to Old Meadonians, while HAC climbed up the table after notching up an impressive away win at Old Suttonians,

Premier League new boys Old Belgravians also recorded their first point of the season, after a 1-1 draw with Parkfield, and Champions Albanian returned to winning ways with a 2-1 win over last year's runners-up Old Minchendenians, who are still yet to record their first win of the season.

This weekend's results leave five teams tied at the top of the table, with both of the remaining 100% records falling. Four of those sides meet next weekend, adding an extra layer of excitement to the coming round of fixtures, while Old Minchendenians will be desperate to pick up their first win of the season at home to Old Suttonians.
