


## [Registering for Members Services](#)


Before a referee can access Members Services you will need to register and get a password to access your details, and match information.

**Step 1:** visit your county website (London and Essex FA referees cannot use their own sites, and will need to login via [www.amateur-fa.com](http://www.amateur-fa.com)).

**Request Access**

A range of online services are now available to members of this Association. Using the FA's FAN technology, these services enable you to have access to information 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

All services require you to log in with a FAN number and password, when you have logged in you will be given access to information based on your roles in football.

Are you:

- **Club Official:** Secretary, Chairman or Treasurer
- **League Official:** Secretary, Chairman or Treasurer
- **Registered Referee**
- **Qualified Coach**

Select which online service you would like access to. If you fill more than one of the roles listed then start by selecting your most prominent role.

**Step 4:** enter your FA Number (FAN) and also your County Registration Number. If you do not know either of these, please contact your County FA. Note that the FA Numbers used to be known as NPD Numbers.
