

## **AFC Executive – 14th May 2019 – Secretary's Report**

### **Items for Information**

- Draft constitution has been sent to all clubs for initial comment – so far 40 have replied.
- Various News updates on refs and clubs are being sent by AFA Office – key info
  - Bob Leeds retires on 17/5
  - Matt Leary has ended his employment in office
  - Refs Registration pushed back to June 2019
  - League Sanctioning is on hold until 1<sup>st</sup> July 2019
  - Grassroots Football awards

  - New Laws of Game for 19/20. Lots of changes for refs and clubs to digest!!

- All Clubs with float deficits have been written too and asked to pay the top up.

### **Items for Consideration**

- Alan Robinson has resigned from his position as Fines Secretary from 19/20.
- What is happening regarding the move to WGS player registration in 19/20 – JW to update and this needs urgent attention as it has also been raised by Club Committee
- Referees Fees for 2019/20, The AFA have set the Referees fee at £37 and AR fee at £30 (both a £3 increase from 18/19) .We need to be competitive and so a decision needs to be made regarding our proposal to increase Refs fees to £40 for AFC organised matches..
