1. Apologies for Absence

Apologies were received from; Neill Johnstone; Tony Julien; Ian Andrews; and, Jamie Brunton

2. Minutes of 18th October

Taken as a true record and no matters arising

3. Changes in Constitution since the start of the season

We have the following changes from the beginning of the season with the withdrawal of:

- Old Minchendenians 2nd XI from Senior Two North;
- Southgate Olympic 2nd XI from Intermediate North;
 Old Parmiterians 6th XI from Four North;
- UCL Academicals 2nd XI from Senior Two North;
- Kings Old Boys 1st XI from Senior Three South;
- Clapham Old Xaverians 4th XI form Four South;
- Old Paulines 2nd XI from One South; and
- Hale End Athletic 3rd XI from Three North

Southgate Olympic had lost a significant number of 1st XI players but intended to continue in the Premier Division but had been given a couple of weeks off to sort themselves out.

Mickleham had been experiencing issues with SOF in respect of their 1st XI and had enquired about removing them but had not made a formal request.

4. Abandoned games and incomplete matches

 Albanian III v Latymer Old Boys II – One North 19 January – the match was abandoned following indiscipline by both teams. A decision would be made following the outcome of the AFA hearing as both clubs were charged.

5. Review of Inconsistent League Positions

Nothing obvious to report.

6. Constitution proposal for 2019/20

JW table a draft proposing regionalisation up to and including Senior One. The issue was debated and deferred until the next meeting. The option of regionalisation including the Premier was ruled out.

7. Reigatians playing of an unregistered player

The club had been charged by the AFA with paying Ben Simmonds in three 1st XI matches whilst under suspension. Two of these matches were in Senior Division One on 10th & 17th November with the other in the AFA Surrey/Kent Senior Cup. The committee debated whether a sanction should still be imposed given the passage of time and agreed that it should. However, a decision was deferred given the lack of numbers at the meeting.

8. LMS Reports

All divisions were progressing well with no major causes for concern partly due to the number of small divisions.

9. LOB Cups

Again progressing very well but the arrangement of finals was becoming more difficult due to clubs feeling that they could not provide volunteers on the day.

10. Spring Cups

Given the progress in the league it was decided to go ahead with Spring Cups and JW had invited both the Arthurian & Southern Amateur Leagues to join in.
